

Camp Rangi Woods

Totara Reserve Regional Park Pohangina Valley

Welcome to Camp Rangi Woods.

Camp Rangi Woods can sleep up to 70 in beds. More can be accommodated on a stage area if you bring your own mattresses.. Accommodation is in the form of 9 cabins containing bunk beds with mattresses. Plus the Barclay cabin which has 3 bedrooms sleeping two per room in single beds. All rooms have wall heaters.

The camp phone number is 06 3294876 and can only be used for local calls

Upon arrival at the camp enter the hall through a door at the car park side of the building. You will require a torch if arriving after dark.

The power will be on.

Power, lighting and heaters are available in all rooms.

The hot water may take a few hours to heat. In the Barclay Cabin the hot water is via gas, so will heat on demand.

Hot water is available via an electric heater in the kitchen. It will take about 10mins to heat. The reset button is on the top of the heater if required to reset.

Wood for the fire is kept in the tin shed alongside the Barclay Cabin. Key provided. Please make sure you lock the wood shed after yourself. The fire has an electric fan to assist in heating. Simply light the fire, plug the fan in and switch on.

If during your stay you are approached by outsiders to view the camp facilities, it is at your discretion. You can simply refer them to the camp manager for a later viewing.

Check in time is Midday or whatever you have arranged with the camp manager.

The keys will be in the managers letterbox at 2393 Pohangina road.

Please note the camp has security surveillance and alarm system. Please do not interfere with this. The alarm will be switched off before you arrive.

How to get to Camp Rangi Woods

From Ashhurst drive north on Pohangina road for 9km, turn right into Pohangina Valley East road and travel for 14km. Turn left into Churchill Drive, travel for 1km. The camp entrance is slightly left into Totara Reserve. Follow the metal road and the camp is on your left.

The gate code for Totara Reserve is 1970. Please take a note of this otherwise during winter you may not be able to enter the reserve.
